This Month in Maritime History: September 28, 1994 Sinking of the Passenger Ferry *Estonia*

The *Estonia* was a 515' passenger and vehicle ferry that was launched in 1980. The ship could carry 2,000 passengers and 460 cars. It had sailed under various names and on different routes prior to 1993,



when it was put into service carrying passengers across the Baltic Sea between Tallinn, Estonia and Stockholm, Sweden. One unique feature of the ship would play a role in its demise. The ship had a bow door that swung upward to allow deployment of a vehicle ramp.

On September 28, 1994 the ship was crossing the Baltic Sea and headed towards Stockholm. The ship was carrying 803 passengers and 186 crew. The winds were force 7-8 on the Beaufort Scale (34 to 45 mph) and the seas were 13-20 feet. Sometime around 1:00 a.m. a loud metallic bang was heard. Indicators for the door and ramp showed no problems, but passengers and crew heard similar noises over the next 10 minutes. At 1:15 a.m. the bow door separated from the hull and the ship immediately took on a 30° to 40° starboard list. By 1:30 the *Estonia* had rolled to 90°. The ship sank by 1:50 a.m.

Of the 989 people on board, only 138 survived. Many died of drowning or hypothermia in the 50° F water.

Investigators later determined that the bow door locking mechanism was under-designed for the conditions under which the vessel operated. This incident provided impetus for a number of changes to interna-



tional vessel safety regulations. Changes included requirements for Voyage Data Recorders, standards regarding the launching of life saving equipment such as life rafts from a listing ship, and special requirements for RO-RO (Roll on—Roll Off) vessels.


