A MESSAGE FROM YOUR SKIPPER REMEMBERING MARK RICHARD HOUCK



Dear FLMC members,

Mark Houck was my former partner and friend. He was a champion of the FLMC and the marine industry. When we first started working together in 2006, he made sure that I immediately renewed my membership. I was a member that was rarely involved and had let my membership lapse. I laugh when I think about that, and that almost 20 years later I'm the Club Skipper. He was a great advocate for anyone he represented, outstanding in the courtroom. We tried cases together, developed business and spent way too many hours talking on a myriad of subjects. He seemed always well versed on every topic one could imagine. Travelling together was always an invitation to talk non-stop at an exhausting pace on everything from work, to family, to sports and life in general. I actually miss that, and firmly believe that I learned a great deal from him. We worked together as equity partners at Houck Anderson, the firm he founded in 1992, and then after our merger, at Chartwell. He joked that it was our eventual disagreements that forced me to break away from him and succeed on my own. He took credit for that. It's funny because it's likely true. After I left Chartwell and joined MG+M, I would run into Mark on occasion; usually at the FLMC Seminar. We would always catch up. He would tell me how impressed he was with me and in what I had accomplished. I knew then, as I know now, that I have adopted a lot of what I learned from him (with my own twist) in what I do today as a lawyer. I often find myself thinking of him, and what it would be like if we still worked together. I believe he would be proud that I finally read the marketing and business development books he bought me and have implemented a lot of what he preached then. To be a successful lawyer is not only measured by what one does in the courtroom, but also by how one develops and maintains his business. Mark was gifted at both. There are a lot of maritime attorneys that have passed through his firm's doors, and whether they want to admit it or not, he definitely left an imprint on them. Mark passed away on March 25, 2022.

May he rest in eternal peace.


