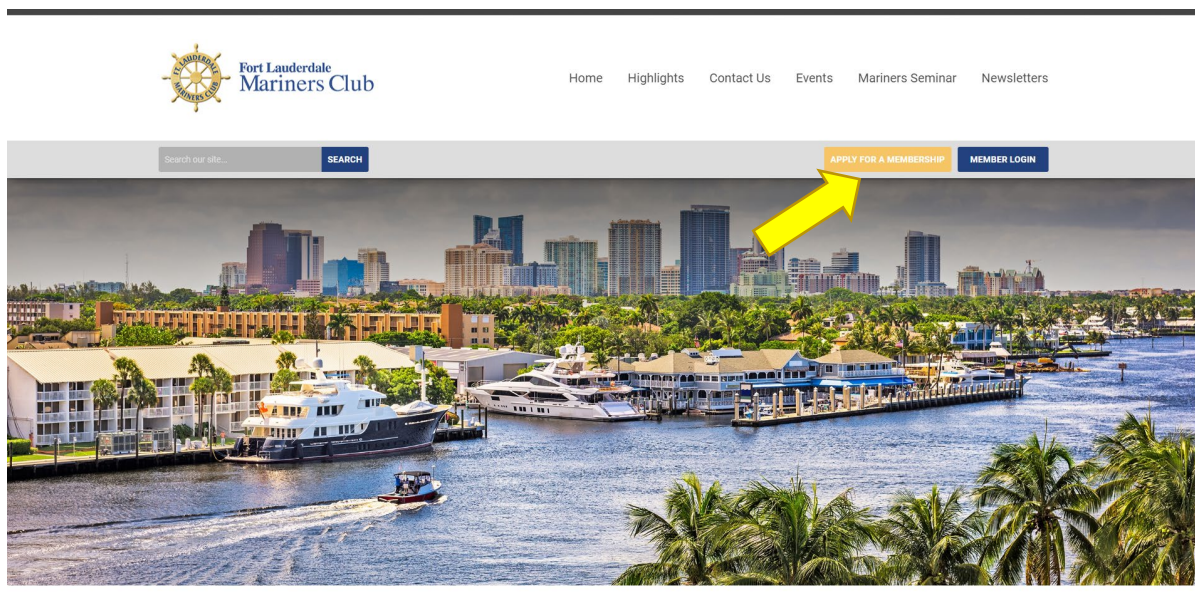


2023 FORT LAUDERDALE MARINERS CLUB **MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL**

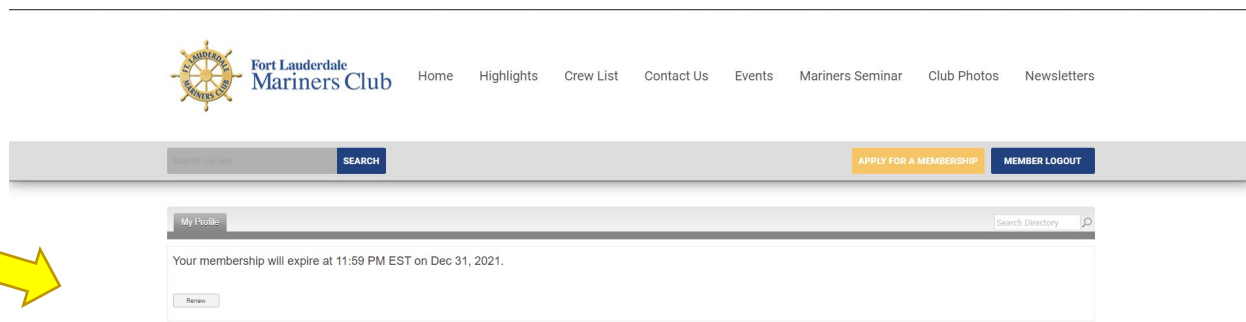
Also, take the time to update your profile to keep up to date with any announcements.

Second, click on “My Profile” and you should see the “Renew” option

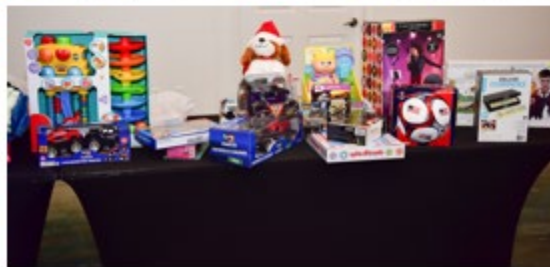
Third, click on “Renew” and proceed to pay for your dues

FLMC is registered to take part in the 2023 Broward County Waterway Clean Up on Saturday, **March 4th, 2023** starting at **09:00 hours**. Our chosen venue is Dania Beach, like last year. The clean-up is organized by the Marine Industries Association of South Florida and is the county's largest and longest-running environmental event. The 2022 cleanup was held on Saturday, March 5th with more than 1,100 volunteers of all ages by land and 300 boats/personal watercraft volunteered throughout 35 sites across Broward County to remove 25 tons of trash and debris from our inland waterways.
